ICNHB pays yearly liability insurance, all stipends for students/director, new ICNHB directory costs and social fund, all of which come from dues and FICNHB. This past year we spent more than we received in dues. Thanks to FICNHB we are OK financially now, but we depend on donations to maintain the current dues.
